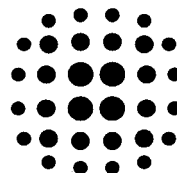

**Regulating the Profession  
Your Report about FDC Law**

Thank you for your recent letter, passed to the SRA by Mr D Clare of the Legal Complaints Service on 12 January 2009.

~~You may recall Miss Aman Virk of The Law Society wrote to you on 7 March 2005~~ under file reference CDT/33561-2003 regarding your complaints about FDC Law. Miss Virk explained that you had not raised any new issues which justified the reopening of your complaint or a new file. Miss Virk therefore explained that The Law Society would not be communicating further with you on this matter, either in writing or on the telephone unless it was clear you were raising new issues or concerns that required further investigation by this office.

The Solicitors' Regulation Authority came into existence on 29 January 2007. Prior to this, the role of regulating solicitors fell to The Law Society. I have reviewed your letter of 18 December 2008. I am satisfied this matter was dealt with by The Law Society under reference CDT/33561-2003 and that you have not raised any new issues which require investigation.

In view of this we will not be responding to further correspondence with you on this matter, either in writing or over the telephone, unless it is clear you are raising new issues or concerns that require further investigation by us. Any correspondence that does not raise new issues will simply be placed on file without further action or response on our part.
